Mining Association rejects NDP's call for a permanent ban on uranium exploration

Halifax - Michelle Landreville, Executive Director of the Mining Association of Nova Scotia (MANS), indicated that the Association was quite surprised at the introduction of a Private Member's bill calling for a permanent ban on uranium exploration in the province of Nova Scotia.

"MANS supports uranium exploration, mining and the nuclear fuel cycle in Nova Scotia, Canada and indeed world wide," states Ms. Landreville.

Nova Scotia remains the only jurisdiction in Canada that does not promote uranium exploration and the Association would like to see this issue discussed in an open and fair manner throughout our province.
