

HRM buys coastal land in Cow Bay for \$200,000 (Halifax Chronicle Herald)

Cow Bay is getting a new park. The 4.6-hectare seaside site is to give coastal access to surfers and others, a news release said Wednesday. "A fragile coastal wetland will be preserved and an important piece of recreational infrastructure for local residents will be created," it said. Situated between the Cow Bay Moose park and Dyke Road, the new park will give surfers, paddlers, walkers and others public access to the Atlantic Ocean. Coun. Jackie Barkhouse (Woodside- Eastern Passage) said a private beachside lot was bought by Halifax Regional Municipality to facilitate development of the park. She said the property cost the city more than \$200,000. A public meeting is set for May 27 at the Cow Bay community hall. Page A9
